The Water Tower

The Water Tower in Giżycko has 120 years old. It is an important monument. It is on a hillock, opposite the School Number 1. It gave water for people over 97 years. It is tall bulding. It has 25 metres high. The Tower has 129 stairs inside. It is of red brick. Henryk Górny has its from 1996.





The Swing Bridge

The Swing Bridge in Giżycko over the Canal Łuczański has 122 years. It weighs 100 tons. One person may rotate the bridge only in 5 minutes. It is amazing and exciting! The car or bus can cross the bridge if they weigh under 2,5 tons. In holiday it is a popular monument.

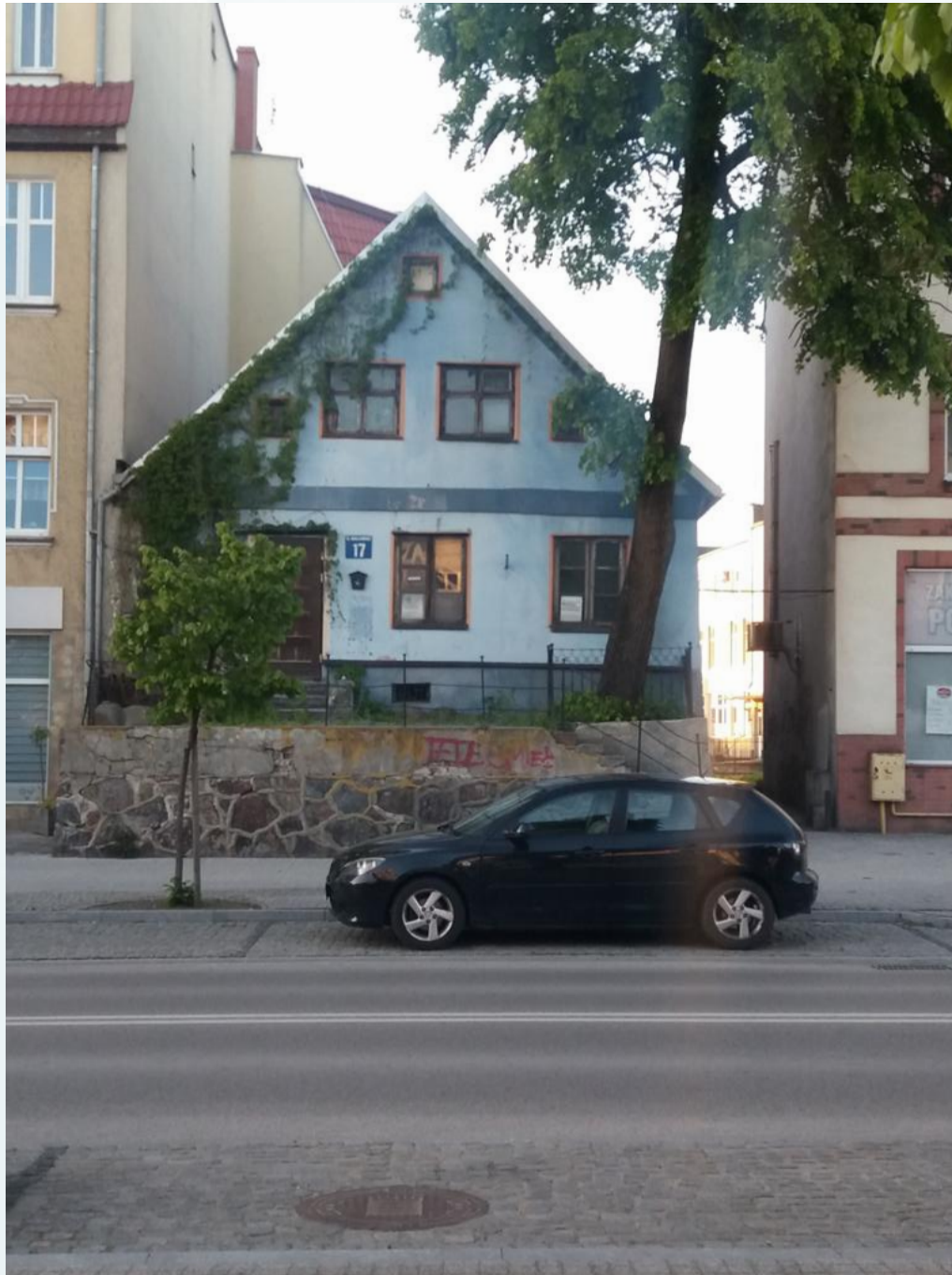




„Small Bakery”
